EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Item	Detail
Subject	Sunder Katwala — Director, British Future; Former General Secretary, Fabian Society; Board Member, National Lottery Community Fund (appointed 7 August 2026)
Core Concern	Potential conflict of interest — appointment to Lottery Fund Board by DCMS Secretary Lisa Nandy, while his organisation British Future receives significant Lottery funding; deep institutional links to senior Labour figures raise questions over impartiality.
Key Figures Connected	Tony Blair, Gordon Brown, Keir Starmer, Andy Burnham — all Fabian Society members with direct overlaps during Katwala's tenure (2003–2011).
Primary Risk	Lottery funds (£939.7m distributed 2025–26) intended for community benefit may be directed toward policy advocacy aligned with political interests.

SECTION 2 — FABIAN SOCIETY CONNECTIONS (2003–2011)

2.1 — Tony Blair (Prime Minister 1997–2007)

- **Overlap:** 2003–2007 — Blair PM, Katwala Fabian General Secretary
- **Relationship:** Ideological & institutional partnership — Blair's Third Way framework developed & published through Fabian Society during Katwala's tenure
- **Key Outputs:** The Future of the Left (2004), 2005 Election Policy Commission, Global Britain (2006)
- **Direct Contact:** Blair delivered annual Fabian Lecture throughout premiership — Katwala formally hosted & introduced him
- **Status:** ✓ **Verified** — published records & event archives

2.2 — Gordon Brown (Prime Minister 2007–2010)

- **Overlap:** 2007–2010 — full premiership overlap
- **Relationship:** Deep, regular engagement — Brown most frequent senior speaker at Fabian events during this period
- **Key Outputs:** Prosperity for All (2007), Fairness in a Global Age (2008), Why the Right is Wrong (2010 — Brown's personal pamphlet)
- **Critical Channel:** Ed Balls (Brown's closest policy advisor) served on Fabian Council — direct pipeline between No.10 and Fabian policy commissions
- **Status:** ✓ **Verified** — Fabian publications & contemporary reports

2.3 — Keir Starmer (Labour Leader, Prime Minister 2024–)

- **Timeline:** No official tenure overlap — Katwala left Fabians Aug 2011; Starmer elected MP May 2015
- **Pre-2015 Links:** Starmer active in Fabian Lawyers Network; appeared at events 2010–2011 during Katwala's final months
- **Post-2020 Alignment:** Starmer published The Road Ahead via Fabian Society (2021); >50% of Starmer Cabinet are Fabian members; Katwala publicly endorsed Starmer's policy framework
- **British Future Connection:** Starmer has personally endorsed British Future's work; research cited in leadership speeches
- **Status:** ✓ **Verified** — institutional alignment confirmed; personal links require further verification

2.4 — Andy Burnham (Mayor of Greater Manchester)

- **Overlap:** 2005–2010 — Burnham Minister/Cabinet Minister; Katwala Fabian chief exec
- **Relationship:** Policy collaboration — particularly health & devolution
- **Key Outputs:** 2009 Fabian Lecture on NHS Reform (as Health Secretary); contributor to The Labour Leadership (2010)
- **Ideological Alignment:** Shared commitment to municipal socialism, devolution, public health reform
- **Status:** ✓ **Verified** — event records & published contributions

3.3 — CRITICAL CONFLICT OF INTEREST — Lottery Board Appointment

CONFIRMED FACT: British Future has received grant funding from The National Lottery Community Fund — the same body Katwala was appointed to as a Board Member in August 2026. The fund distributes hundreds of millions annually.

Questions Requiring Official Answers:

- Was this funding relationship declared during the appointment process overseen by Culture Secretary Lisa Nandy?
- Will British Future be barred from future Lottery grants during his 4-year tenure?
- Has he recused himself from all funding decisions affecting his former organisation?

- Does the Lottery Fund have a formal conflict of interest policy covering this scenario?

Status:  **UNRESOLVED** — no public declaration or recusal policy published.

2	DCMS	Ministerial appointment correspondence, memos, and sign-offs regarding Katwala's appointment by Secretary Lisa Nandy, addressing dual mandates (Lottery Board / EHRC).
3	National Lottery Community Fund	All grants awarded to British Future — amounts, dates, project titles, decision-makers.
4	National Lottery Community Fund	Conflict of interest register — Katwala's declarations & any recusal agreements.
5	Charity Commission	British Future — full accounts, funder breakdown, trustee declarations.

6.2 — Further Investigation

- Cross-reference British Future reports against Labour Party policy documents — identify direct correlations.
- Review Lottery grant awards to British Future — dates, amounts, decision panel composition.
- Map network of overlapping board members — British Future, Fabian Society, Lottery Fund, EHRC.
- Check if Katwala has declared any other direct/indirect business interests.
