Educational Note for Public Viewing: This dossier demonstrates standard open-source intelligence (OSINT) methodology and digital footprint analysis techniques. Covert operational procedures and restricted law enforcement data have been redacted. Citizens can apply these exact investigative workflows independently using public registries and search tools.

1. EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

This dossier compiles open-source intelligence regarding Peter Calvert-Mindell and his associated social media presence. Key analytical findings include:

- He has only one dissolved UK corporate entity on public record.
- His claimed residence in Poole, Dorset appears exclusively on social media without independent public records corroboration.
- His Facebook profile exhibits extreme statistical anomalies consistent with non-personal or operational network usage.
- His claimed relative “Louisa Ebrahim” leaves no verifiable public record footprint across the United Kingdom.
- The profile architecture is deliberately hardened against cross-reference and identification.

11,000+ posts / 110 friends	Extreme statistical imbalance. Normal personal accounts average 100–300 posts over many years. Indicates high-volume posting into hidden groups or automated messaging channels.
No join date displayed	Deliberately hidden via standard platform privacy settings to obscure account antiquity.
Zero employment / education	Minimal identifying professional or community context provided.
Untraceable relative	“Louisa Ebrahim” possesses no verifiable independent presence in UK public records.
Unconfirmed locations	Poole and Monkton appear solely on this profile without external corroboration.

Profile Classification: Inconsistent with a standard civilian personal social media account. Matches characteristics of accounts created for anonymous contact, group-only activity, or hardened operational use.

4. CLAIMED ASSOCIATE: LOUISA EBRAHIM

- No Companies House directorships or secretary entries.
- No property ownership or electoral roll registrations.
- No news, court, or local authority mentions across public datasets.
- No verifiable biographical or geographic link to Peter Calvert-Mindell, Poole, or Monkton anywhere in public data.
- Her existence as a real-world relative remains entirely unconfirmed.

5. OBSERVATIONS & RISK ASSESSMENT

- All identifying personal details originate exclusively from a single private social media profile.
- No independent source corroborates the subject's current residential address or reported family connections.
- The account architecture is structurally optimized to evade cross-reference and identification.
- While open-source data cannot definitively confirm institutional or security service association, it confirms the profile departs radically from typical civilian norms.

6. PUBLIC INVESTIGATION RECOMMENDATIONS

1. **Preserve Digital Evidence:** Capture full-page screenshots of the profile, metrics, listed locations, associate names, and all direct messages received.
2. **Report Platform Abuses:** Submit formal reports for abusive or threatening content to the platform provider citing “false identity / harassment”.
3. **Engage Law Enforcement:** If interactions cross into threatening or illegal behavior, compile evidence packages for submission to local police authorities (e.g., Dorset Police).
4. **Cease Direct Engagement:** Avoid further communication or direct interaction with the account.
5. **Maintain Audit Trail:** Document and log all future inbound contact for investigative continuity.
